ORDINANCE NO. 2017-32

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2017-2018 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE RECEIPT OF A DONATION OF A USED POLICE VEHICLE, VEHICLE INSURANCE, AND SERVICES RELATED TO EXPENDITURES OF USED POLICE VEHICLE FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central did not include within the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year General Budget for the City of Central Police Department, receipt of a donation for a used police vehicle by the City of Central Police Department and related expenditures to put that vehicle in service; and

WHEREAS, the City of Central Police Department has received a donation of a used police vehicle;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year General Budget to properly appropriate funds necessary related to the above stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Vehicles-PD (Account No. 000.421.70.742) is hereby increased by \$3,370.00 to provide for the donated used police vehicle and necessary renovations of the used police vehicle for the City of Central Police Department.

Section 2. Insurance-Vehicle (Account No. 000.421.05.742) is hereby increased by \$630.00 to provide for expenditures related to the cost of insurance for the used police vehicle for the City of Central Police Department.

Section 3. Donations-PD (Account No. 000.364.20) is hereby increased by \$2,000.00 for the donation received related to the used police vehicle and required renovations for the used police vehicle for the City of Central Police Department.

Section 4. Conflicts

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against other ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

Section 5. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 6. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.
