**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2019-2020 FISCAL
YEAR BUDGET FOR RECEIPT OF A \$3,500 FURNITURE
DONATION TO THE CENTRAL POLICE DEPARTMENT
AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS**

WHEREAS, Neighbors Federal Credit Union wishes to donate five desks, one executive table and chairs with a value of \$3,500.00 to the City of Central Police Department;

WHEREAS, the City of Central Police department has a need for the office furniture; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2019-2020 Fiscal Year General Budget to receive the donated office furniture and properly record the assets received.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Budget Amendment

Donations-PD (General Fund Revenue Account No. 000.364.20) is hereby increased by \$3,500.00 for receipt of donated furniture for the City of Central Police Department.

Furniture & Fixtures-PD (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.421.05.743) is hereby increased by \$3,500.00 to record of the donation of furniture received by the City of Central Police Department.

Section 2. Conflicts

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against prior ordinances of the City to the extent there is any conflict.

Section 3. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.
