**ORDINANCE NO. 2019-06**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2018-2019 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR REFUNDS AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS**

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central did not include sufficient funds within the 2018-19 Fiscal Year General Budget for refunds related to Occupational License, Permits, and Contractor License;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central wishes to increase the various refund accounts in the 2018-19 Fiscal Year General Budget to allocate funds accordingly; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year General Budget to appropriate funds necessary related to the above stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

**Section 1.** Refunds-Occupational License (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.415.65.310) is hereby increased by \$1,850 to provide sufficient funds for Occupational License refunds.

**Section 2.** Refunds-Contractor's License (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.415.90.340) is hereby increased by \$250 to provide sufficient funds for Contractor's License refunds.

**Section 3.** Refunds-Permits (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.416.30.340) is hereby increased by \$500 to provide sufficient funds for Permit refunds.

**Section 4. Conflicts**

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against other Ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

**Section 5. Severability**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of

the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

**Section 6. Effective Date**

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.


