ORDINANCE NO. 2017-04

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2016-2017 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR UNIFORMS AND REPAIRS & MAINTENANCE AND TO ACCOUNT FOR A REDUCTION IN SMALL EQUIPMENT FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central included funds in Small Equipment for purchase of equipment in the 2016-17 Fiscal Year General Fund Budget for the City of Central Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central recognizes that adequate funds for Uniforms and Repairs & Maintenance were not provided in the 2016-17 Fiscal Year General Fund Budget for the City of Central Police Department;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central wishes to reduce the funds allocated to Small Equipment and reallocate those funds to Uniforms and Repairs & Maintenance within the Central Police Department;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2016-2017 Fiscal Year General Budget to properly appropriate necessary funds related to the above-stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Uniforms (General Fund Account No. 000.421.20.800) is hereby increased by \$1,000.00 to provide for expenditures related to uniform expenditures for the City of Central Police Department.

Section 2. Repairs & Maintenance (General Fund Account No. 000.421.70.430) is hereby increased by \$4,000.00 to provide for expenditures related to repairs and maintenance of vehicles and equipment for the City of Central Police Department.

Section 3. Small Equipment (General Fund Account No. 000.421.05.744) is hereby decreased by \$5,000.00 so that additional funds related to uniforms and repairs and maintenance can be provided for the City of Central Police Department.

Section 4. Conflicts

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against other ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

Section 5. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 6. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.
