ORDINANCE NO. 2018-34

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2018-2019 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR RELOCATION AND IMPROVEMENTS TO THE SECURITY SYSTEM FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central received a donated building located at 13505 Hooper Road from East Baton Rouge Parish in August 2016; and

WHEREAS, the City of Central Police department is in the process of renovating and relocating to the building located at 13505 Hooper Road; and

WHEREAS, the expenditures for the relocation and improvements of the security system were included in the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year General Fund Budget;

WHEREAS, the relocation and improvements were not installed and completed until July 2018;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central did not include the expenditures for the relocation and improvements of the security system for the City of Central Police Department in the 2018-19 Fiscal Year Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year Budget to properly appropriate necessary funds related to the above-stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Repairs & Maint-Vehicles & Equip-PD (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.421.70.430) is hereby increased by \$260.00 to provide for expenditures to relocate the existing security system to the building located at 13505 Hooper Road for the City of Central Police Department.

Section 2. Equipment-PD (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.421.70.742) is hereby increased by \$9,140.00 to provide for expenditures to make improvements to the existing security system in the building located at 13505 Hooper Road.

Section 3. Conflicts

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against other Ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

Section 4. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.






