**ORDINANCE NO. 2018-26**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2018-2019 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR ADDITIONAL RENT FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS**

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central received a donated building located at 13505 Hooper Road from East Baton Rouge Parish in August 2016; and

WHEREAS, the City of Central Police department is relocating to the building located at 13505 Hooper Road; and

WHEREAS the relocation of the City of Central Police Department required renovation of the building located at 13505 Hooper Road; and

WHEREAS the renovation of the building was to be completed during July 2018 and the City of Central Police department would occupy the building by the end of July 2018; and

WHEREAS the renovations of the building were not completed in time for the City of Central Police department to effectively move into the building by the end of July 2018 and therefore an additional month's rent will be required at the current location; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central did not include the additional rent for the City of Central Police Department in the 2018-19 Fiscal Year Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year Budget to properly appropriate necessary funds related to the above-stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

**Section 1.** Rent (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.421.05.441) is hereby increased by \$1,325 to provide for one month of additional rent for the City of Central Police department.

**Section 2. Conflicts**

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against prior ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

**Section 3. Severability**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

**Section 4. Effective Date**

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.




