**ORDINANCE NO. 2019-15**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2018-2019 FISCAL YEAR GENERAL BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF CENTRAL POLICE DEPARTMENT OFFICE AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS**

WHEREAS, Chief of Police Roger Corcoran, has evaluated the funds remaining in the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year General Budget for the City of Central Police Department Office;

WHEREAS, Chief Corcoran has determined that the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year General Budget for the City of Central Police Department Office adopted prior to his tenure in office is inconsistent with the current priorities of the Police Department;

WHEREAS, Chief Corcoran requests amendment to the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year General Budget to move funding from some categories to other categories where he has determined additional funding will be needed during the 2018-2019 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the amendment does not increase the total funding allocated in the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year General Budget for the City of Central Police Department Office.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

**Section 1. Decreases in Budgeted Funds.**

- A. Software-PD (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.421.05.000) is hereby reduced by \$3,500.
- B. Equipment-PD (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.421.05.741) is hereby reduced by \$1,000.
- C. Computer Repairs & Maintenance (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.421.80.430) is hereby reduced by \$1,000.

**Section 2. Increases in Budgeted Funds.**

- A. Insurance-Liability (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.421.05.520) is hereby increased by \$1,000.
- B. Small Equipment-PD (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.421.05.744) is hereby increased by \$1,000.

C. Law Enforcement Supplies (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.421.20.610) is hereby increased by \$1,000.

D. Repairs & Maintenance-Vehicles (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.421.70.430) is hereby increased by \$2,500.

### Section 3. Conflicts

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against prior ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

### Section 4. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

### Section 5. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.




