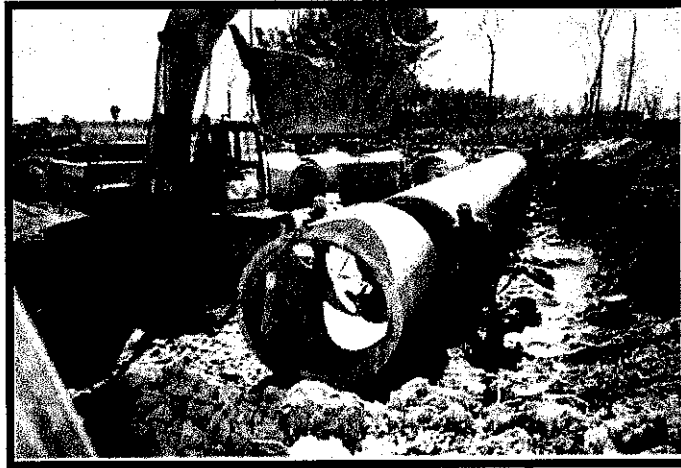
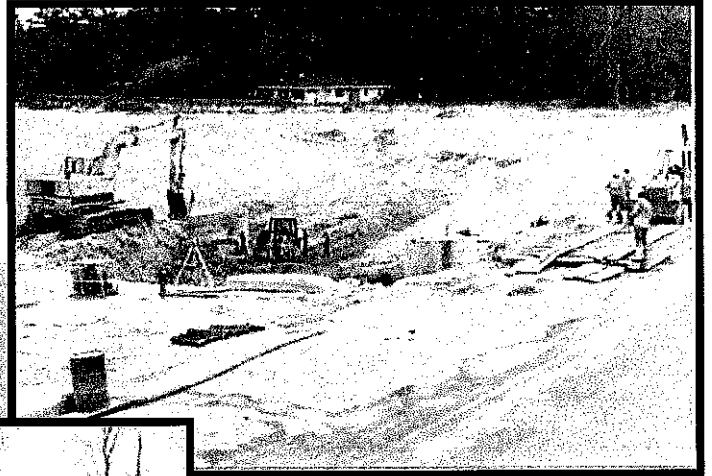

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SECTION ONE: QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE

1.1 OVERVIEW

We at Stranco, LLC (Stranco) have the qualifications and experience to fulfill our commitment to work for you in meeting and exceeding all requirements necessary to assist the City of Central in recovery and remediation actions following a disaster event. Under our current name of Stranco, we have been in the business of assisting folks in recovering from disasters of all types—from natural to man-made—since 1982.

Stranco has completed hundreds of projects in the states of Alabama, Arkansas, Georgia, Florida, Louisiana, Mississippi, Tennessee and Texas. Completed project fees range up to millions of dollars. Project work tasks vary in a range from simple cleanup to extremely complex multi-task jobs involving sophisticated remediation techniques such as pumping sludge and contaminated liquids into bulk liquid rail cars for transportation to disposal sites.

Stranco owns a wide variety of specialized and heavy equipment designed to complete environmental remediation, demolition, and civil construction projects. This equipment includes excavators, wheel loaders, bulldozers, motor graders, tractor/trailer, end dumps and tankers, roll off boxes and rail trailers, compaction equipment and much more. Each project is evaluated during the bid process to determine the most cost-effective approach to meeting equipment requirements.

1.2 STAFF ORGANIZATION FOR PROJECT

We are proposing two leadership personnel to spearhead this project and guide the team to success. Both of these individuals have been involved as leaders in similar (and highly successful) disaster management projects.

1.3 EXPERIENCE REMOVING SPECIALTY DEBRIS

Stranco has extensive experience in removing and remediating sites where hazardous debris is present. Much of this experience includes working with various governmental entities as described next.

1.4 EXPERIENCE WORKING WITH GOVERNMENT ENTITIES

Stranco employees have extensive experience working with government officials such as members of FEMA and the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).

For example, as the result of a major train derailment involving over 100 derailed cars in Louisiana, almost 90,000 cubic yards of soil was contaminated. Stranco's remediation work on this project was completed over an 18-month period. No injuries or worker exposure problems were experienced during operations. This work was performed under the daily inspection of Environmental consultants, the Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality, EPA inspectors, railroad officials, Louisiana State Police Hazardous Materials Team, City officials, Parish officials, and the Press.

Stranco abides by the requirements of Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and does not discriminate against employees or applicants due to color, race, religion, sex, handicap or national origin. Furthermore, Stranco takes Affirmative Action pursuant to Executive Order #11246 and the National Vocational Rehabilitation Act of 1973.

We always adhere to the mandate dictated by the Copeland "Anti-Kickback" Act which provides that each Contractor or sub grantee shall be prohibited from inducing by any means, any person employed in the completion of work, to give up any part of the compensation to which he is otherwise entitled. Stranco agrees to adhere to the provisions issued under Section 306 of the Clean Air Act.

We recognize the mandatory standards and policies relating to energy efficiency, which are contained in the State Energy Conservation Plan.

We adhere to the provisions requiring compliance with requirements issued under Section 508 of the Clean Water Act.

Stranco complies with Federal statutes required in the Anti-Lobbying Act and the Debarment Act.

Stranco complies with section 6002 of the Solid Waste Disposal Act , as amended by the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

1.8 AVAILABILITY OF KEY PERSONNEL

Since we are a local Louisiana company and do not hunt around the world for contracts, our availability is an easy requirement to meet and exceed. One of the key personnel designated for this project, Tim Mann, lives in Baton Rouge--only a few miles from the City of Central. Key personnel resumes are found in the Appendix to this proposal. You can count on Stranco personnel to be there when you need us.

1.9 TYPES AND QUANTITY OF EQUIPMENT AVAILABLE

Stranco owns a wide variety of specialized and heavy equipment to complete environmental remediation, demolition, and civil construction projects. For example, we own and operate a fleet of over thirty late-model tractor/trailers that are maintained to a standard of excellence that meets or exceeds all DOT regulations. Stranco-owned equipment available for this project is more than sufficient for the performance of the work proposed for this project. However, should it become necessary, we also have the ability to obtain from other sources that Stranco has been doing business with for years.

SECTION TWO: APPROACH AND METHODOLOGY

The Stranco project management system has been developed to efficiently coordinate the total project effort using techniques that include

- Standard operating procedures
- Client/project team communication
- Administrative controls
- Careful management/monitoring of scope, schedule, and budget
- Standardized project accounting and cost tracking systems.

Cost Control

Stranco is committed to delivering quality services on time and within budget. To determine costs, the individual elements of each project are measured as a function of time. Stranco used the FACTS database program that tracks real-time projects costs as a function of the percent complete of each task to determine cost controls.

Beginning with the first day of activity in the field, and each day of the project, the client is provided with a Daily Report of the Schedule of Values and percent complete of each contractual value. This document provides Client review and participation in determining the pay measures earned for each day's activity while the activities are still fresh in everyone's mind. It serves to reduce conflicts and prevent confusion during the project.

Quality Control

Stranco is committed to providing quality services and strives for continuous improvement. Our executive management is actively involved in ensuring that services meet or exceed client requirements. The General manager and designated project QA representative are authorized to stop work if QA objectives are not being achieved.

Documents and Records

Stranco uses centralized corporate document controls to ensure that documents and records will be controlled, protected, maintained and submitted according to contract specifications.

Design

Our quality assurance program establishes controls to ensure the design is accurate and will convey specifications, drawings, procedures and work instructions accurately. All designs and project plans are subject to a rigorous process of review and approval prior to use.

Standard Operating Procedures

Written protocols, standard operating procedures and other control measures are used to ensure work is performed to established technical standards. Stranco implements a three-phase quality control system (preparatory, initial, and final control) during the execution of our project work. Field instrumentation is maintained and calibrated in accordance with established Stranco protocols. All written documentation supporting our system is reviewed periodically to ensure it is still applicable to the current work environment.

Procurement

Stranco's procurement control system ensures materials and services meet the specification requirements, are suitable for their intended use, and are received and maintained in good condition prior to use.

Inspection, Tests and Assessments

Acceptance, inspections and tests of specified items, services and processes are conducted using established acceptance and performance criteria. All routine inspections and acceptance inspections or tests are formally documented and submitted as required. Assessments are conducted to measure service quality, adequacy of work performed, and to identify areas for improvement.
