ORDINANCE NO. 2018-38

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2018-2019 FISCAL YEAR HALF-CENT FUND BUDGET AND CAPITAL OUTLAY BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR THE HOOPER ROAD SIDEWALK PROJECT AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Council and Mayor of the City of Central has recognized a need for a sidewalk on the north side of Hooper Road between Live Oak Grove and Liberty Park Drive;

WHEREAS, the City of Central estimates costs of \$20,000 related to the Hooper Road Sidewalk Project;

WHEREAS, the Council did not included funding the Hooper Road Sidewalk Project within the City of Central in the 2018-19 Fiscal Year Half-Cent Fund and Capital Outlay Fund Budgets;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year Half-Cent Fund Budget and Capital Outlay Fund Budget to properly appropriate the \$20,000 in costs related to the above stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Transfer to CO&I Fund - Beautification (Half-Cent Fund Expenditure Account No. 120.491.21.300) is hereby increased by \$20,000 for the transfer of funds to the Capital Outlay Fund for the estimated costs related to the Hooper Road Sidewalk Project.

Section 2. Transfer from HC Fund – Beautification (Capital Outlay Fund Revenue Account No. 210.391.20.300) is hereby increased by \$20,000 to provide for transfer of funds from the Half Cent Fund to the Capital Outlay Fund for the estimated costs related to the Hooper Road Sidewalk Project.

Section 3. HC – Road Beautification (Capital Outlay Fund Expenditure Account No. 210.431.99.730) is hereby increased by \$20,000 to provide for the estimated costs related to the Hooper Road Sidewalk Project.

Section 4. Conflicts

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against other Ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

Section 5. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 6. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.




