ORDINANCE NO. 2018-06

AN ORDINANCE TO ENACT TITLE 7, CHAPTER 14, SECTION 7.14.31 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF CENTRAL RELATIVE TO SEWERAGE REGULATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR ALL RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Central desires to enact certain provisions in the City's ordinances related to sewerage regulation:

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1: Title 7, Chapter 14, Section 7.14.31 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Central is hereby enacted, so as to read as follows:

TITLE 26. DEVELOPMENT CODE

Chapter 14. UTILITIES

Section 7-14-31. Sewerage Regulation

- (a) The most recent City of Baton Rouge and Parish of East Baton Rouge regulations and ordinances with regard to Sewerage, Chapter 5, Part 1, Section 250 , et seq., as amended and published, are hereby adopted as the regulations and ordinances governing the sewerage in the City of Central.

Section 2: Conflicts

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against prior ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

Section 3: Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 4: Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.




