**ORDINANCE NO. 2019-05**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2018-19 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES RELATED TO FLOOD RECOVERY AND FLOOD HAZARD MITIGATION AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS**

WHEREAS, a heavy rain event which began during the second week of August 2016 caused catastrophic flooding within the City of Central;

WHEREAS, as a result of such flooding, the City of Central and its citizens sustained significant damages;

WHEREAS, the City of Central has applied for and intends to continue to apply for funding for flood recovery and flood mitigation projects to improve drainage within the City of Central in an effort to repair damages and/or mitigate flooding hazards;

WHEREAS, the City of Central entered into a contract with CSRS through September 19, 2019 to provide necessary professional services and technical assistance for applications for funding through FEMA programs administered under the Stafford Act, including but not limited to Public Assistance, Individual Assistance, Hazard Mitigation Grant Program, Direct Federal Assistance, and CDL programs as described in RFP 2016-003, the Community Development Block Grant Program, United States Army Corp Programs and La DOTD Programs, to develop a master drainage plan and for planning and development of a resiliency district;

WHEREAS, the professional services and technical assistance are anticipated to increase funding opportunities for flood recovery and flood hazard mitigation; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2018-19 Fiscal Year Budget to appropriate additional funding for necessary to continue the contract through June 30, 2019.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

**Section 1.** Emergency (Emergency Service, Drainage, & Local Road Improvement & Maintenance Fund Expenditure Account No. 110.431.99.000) is hereby increased by \$35,000 to provide for expenditures related to the technical assistance for grants opportunities for the City of Central.

**Section 2.** Drainage (Emergency Service, Drainage, & Local Road Improvement & Maintenance Fund Expenditure Account No. 110.431.60.000) is hereby increased by \$170,000 to provide for the expenditures related to the completion of a master drainage plan for the City of Central.

**Section 3.** Zoning & Elevation Studies/Services (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.418.20.333) is hereby increased by \$35,000 for expenditures related to the planning and development of a resiliency district within the City of Central.

**Section 4: Conflicts**

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against other ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

**Section 5: Severability**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

**Section 6: Effective Date**

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.
