8	PERMIT IN ORDER TO PERMIT THE EXPANSION OF AN EXISTING CHURCH
9	CAMPUS WITH THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF CHURCH EDUCATION
10	BUILDING
11	(Central Church, 11681 Greenwell Springs Port Hudson Road)
12	
13	WHEREAS, application has been made to rezone part of an approximate 1.55-acre lot
14	from LC-1 (Light Commercial One District) to R/A (Rural/Agricultural District) in order to
15	permit the expansion of an existing church campus with the construction and operation of church
16	education building; and
17	WHERE AC a many of the state of
18	WHEREAS, a part of the subject property is already zoned R/A; and
19	WHERE AC the area around the subject property includes lavy density residential
20 21	WHEREAS, the area around the subject property includes low density residential,
22	undeveloped property and property used for agricultural purposes; and
23	WHEREAS, the area around the subject property is R/A; and
24	WHEREAS, the area around the subject property is NA, and
25	WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on November 21, 2019 before the City of Central
26	Zoning Commission; and
27	Zoming commission, and
28	WHEREAS, the Zoning Commission recommend approval of the rezoning and
29	Conditional Use Permit for the expansion of the existing church campus with the construction
30	and operation of church education building subject to certain conditions;
31	
32	NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of
33	Louisiana as follows:
34	
35	Section 1: That the property that is the subject of this Ordinance is legally described
36	in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof.
37	
38	Section 2: That the portion of the subject property not already zoned R/A
39	(Rural/Agricultural District) is hereby rezoned R/A and a conditional use permit is granted to
40	permit the expansion of the existing church campus with the construction and operation of
41	church education building subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this Ordinance. The
42	documents and modifications thereto which condition this approval and other conditions are as
43	follows:

1	1. Central Church, Site & Overall Plan, dated 11/7/19, Sheet A101.
2	2. Prior to issuance of any construction permits, applicant shall submit landscaping
3	plans to City staff for review and obtain plan approval.
4	3. All landscaping and all new parking spaces shall be installed prior to issuance of an
5	Occupancy Certificate for the education building.
6	
7	Section 3: The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against
8	other ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict. Except for the
9	foregoing, the use of the subject property is subject to the terms of all applicable ordinances and
10	regulations of the City of Central, including any amendment thereto.
11	
12	Section 4: Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of
13	this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of
14	invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the
15	part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of
16	invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.
17	
18	Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.
19
