ORDINANCE NO. 2017-18

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2017-2018 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FOR THE TRANSFER OF FLOOD DONATIONS AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the City of Central received cash donations for flood relief after the August 2016 Flood Event;

WHEREAS, the Council and the Mayor for the City of Central desires to use the donated funds for citizens in the City of Central affected by the August 2016 Flood Event;

WHEREAS, the Council and Mayor for the City of Central recognize that the Central Community Alliance Foundation (CCAF) provides assistance to citizens in the City of Central that are in need of school supplies and uniforms;

WHEREAS, CCAF provided school supplies and uniforms to citizens affected by the August 2016 Flood Event;

WHEREAS, the Council and Mayor for the City of Central desires to transfer cash donations received for flood relief to CCAF to cover the costs of assistance provided to citizens affected by the August 2016 Flood Event;

WHEREAS, The Council and Mayor desires to amend the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year General Budget to properly transfer funds necessary related to the above stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Public Assistance (Account No. 000.444.30.900) is hereby increased by \$21,282.34 to provide for the transfer of flood relief donations to CCAF.

Section 2. Conflicts

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against prior ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

Section 3. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of

the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.




