ORDINANCE NO. 2019-52

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2019-2020 FISCAL YEAR GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO TRANSFER \$1,000 FROM REPAIRS & MAINTENANCE VEHICLES & EQUIPMENT TO SOFTWARE FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central included funds for various software expenditures in the 2019-2020 Fiscal Year General Fund Budget for the City of Central Police Department;

WHEREAS, the cost of the annual software renewals for the City of Central Police Department were underestimated;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to transfer funds appropriated for repairs and maintenance of police vehicles and equipment to fund software for the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2019-2020 Fiscal Year General Budget related to the above-stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Software-PD (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.421.05.000) is hereby increased by \$1,000.00 to provide for expenditures related to software renewals for the City of Central Police Department.

Section 2. Repairs & Maint-Vehicles & Equip (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.421.70.430) is hereby decreased by \$1,000.00 to provide funds for expenditures related to software renewals for the City of Central Police Department.

Section 3. Conflicts

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against prior ordinances of the City to the extent there is any conflict.

Section 4 Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the

validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.


