ORDINANCE NO. 2020-16

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE GENERAL FUND BUDGET AND THE DEDICATED FUND BUDGETS FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES, DRAINAGE, AND LOCAL ROAD IMPROVEMENT & MAINTENANCE, HALF CENT SALES AND USE TAX, MOVEBR, TRAFFIC CONTRIBUTION AND CAPITAL OUTLAY & IMPROVEMENT FOR THE 2019-2020 FISCAL YEAR AND PROVIDING FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 2019-26 the Council for the City of Central adopted the General Fund Budget and the Dedicated Fund Budgets for Emergency Services, Drainage, and Local Road Improvement & Maintenance (“ESDLRIM”), Half Cent Sales and Use Tax, MoveBR Traffic Contribution and Capital Outlay & Improvement (collectively “Budgets”) for the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2019 and ending on June 30, 2020 (“2019-2020 Fiscal Year”); and

WHEREAS, the Budgets adopted by Ordinance No. 2019-26 have been amended to include revenues and donations anticipated or received after adoption of the Budgets and to include expenses anticipated or incurred after adoption of the Budgets. Specifically, the Budgets have been amended by Ordinance No. 2019-30 (to increase funding for flood control by \$4,000,000 for the Amite River Tributary Project); Ordinance No. 2019-31 (to increase funding for flood control); Ordinance No. 2019-32 (to appropriate additional funds for benefits); Ordinance No. 2019-33 (to transfer funds from the General Fund to ESDLRIM); Ordinance No. 2019-34 (to amend the Franchise Fee Revenues allocations); Ordinance No. 2019-37 (to recognize the donation of a vehicle and revenue from the sale of surplus property); Ordinance No. 2019-38 (to appropriate funds for the State/Federal Project to improve Thibodeaux Road); Ordinance No. 2019-40 (to appropriate additional funds for liability insurance); Ordinance No. 2019-41 (to recognize a donation of furniture); Ordinance No. 2019-46 (to replace a damaged vehicle); Ordinance No. 2019-50 (to appropriate appraisal fees); Ordinance No. 2019-51 (to fund driveway replacements for drainage repairs); Ordinance Nos. 2019-52 and 2020-02 (to transfer funds within the Police Department Budget); and Ordinance No. 2020-06 (to appropriate LGAP Grant Funds).

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the 2019-2020 Fiscal Year Budgets to comply with the Local Governmental Budget Act, La. R.S. 38:1201, *et seq.*

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana:

Section 1. Budget Amendments. The amendments to General Fund Budget and the Dedicated Fund Budgets for the Emergency Services, Drainage, and Local Road Improvement & Maintenance, Half Cent Sales and Use Tax, MoveBR, Traffic Contribution, Capital Outlay &

Improvement Funds and for the 2019-2020 fiscal year in Exhibit A, City of Central Budget 2019-2020 attached hereto, are adopted.

Section 2. Conflicts. The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against prior ordinances of the City to the extent there is any conflict.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication in the Official Journal.


