ORDINANCE NO. 2017-21

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2017-2018 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR ADDITIONAL COST OF POLICE UNITS FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central included funds in Vehicles-Police Department for the purchase of two new Ford Interceptor SUV Patrol Units in the 2017-18 Fiscal Year General Fund Budget for the City of Central Police Department; and

WHEREAS, since the preparation and adoption of the 2017-18 General Fund Budget, the cost of the two new units has increased from \$52,507.18 to \$54,666.46.

WHEREAS the Council for the City of Central recognizes that as a result of the increased cost of the Police Units, adequate funds for Vehicles-Police Department were not provided in the 2017-18 Fiscal Year General Fund Budget for the City of Central Police Department;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central wishes to increase the funds allocated to Vehicles-Police Department within the Central Police Department;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year General Budget to properly appropriate necessary funds related to the above-stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Vehicles-Police Department (General Fund Account No. 000.421.70.742) is hereby increased by \$2,159.28 to provide for the increased costs of the new Ford Interceptor SUV Patrol Units for the City of Central Police Department.

Section 2. Conflicts

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against other ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

Section 3. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of

the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.






