ORDINANCE NO. 2017-14

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING THE GENERAL FUND BUDGET AND THE DEDICATED FUND BUDGETS FOR THE EMERGENCY SERVICES, DRAINAGE, AND LOCAL ROAD IMPROVEMENT & MAINTENANCE FUND FEES, THE HALF CENT SALES AND USE TAX, THE TRAFFIC CONTRIBUTION, AND THE CAPITAL OUTLAY & IMPROVEMNT FUNDS FOR THE 2017-2018 FISCAL YEAR AND PROVIDING FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, I. M. Shelton, Jr., in his capacity as Mayor of the City of Central, prepared the proposed General Fund Budget and the Dedicated Fund Budgets for the Emergency Services, Drainage, and Local Road Improvement & Maintenance Fund Fee, the Half Cent Sales and Use Tax, the Traffic Contribution, and the Capital Outlay & Improvement Funds for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2017 and ending June 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the proposed General Fund Budget and the Dedicated Fund Budgets for the Emergency Services, Drainage, and Local Road Improvement & Maintenance Fund Fees, the Half Cent Sales and Use Tax, the Traffic Contribution, and the Capital Outlay & Improvement Funds were submitted to this City Council for review and consideration prior to introduction; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing on the proposed General Fund Budget and the Dedicated Fund Budgets for the Emergency Services, Drainage, and Local Road Improvement & Maintenance Fund Fees, the Half Cent Sales and Use Tax, the Traffic Contribution, and the Capital Outlay & Improvement Funds were timely published in the Advocate; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the proposed General Fund Budget and the Dedicated Fund Budgets for the Emergency Services, Drainage, and Local Road Improvement & Maintenance Fund Fees, the Half Cent Sales and Use Tax, the Traffic Contribution, and the Capital Outlay & Improvement Funds was conducted;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana:

Section 1. General Fund. The General Fund Budget for the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year is hereby adopted as shown in Exhibit A – City of Central Budget 2017-18 attached hereto.

Section 2. Emergency Services, Drainage, and Local Road Improvement & Maintenance Fund Fee. The Dedicated Fund Budget for the Emergency Services, Drainage, and Local Road Improvement & Maintenance Fund Fees for the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year as shown in Exhibit A – City of Central Budget 2017-18 attached here is hereby adopted.

Section 3. Half-Cent Sales and Use Tax. The Dedicated Fund Budget for the Half Cent Sales and Use Tax for the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year as shown in Exhibit A – City of Central Budget

2017-18 attached hereto is hereby adopted.

Section 4. Traffic Contribution. The Dedicated Fund Budget for the Traffic Contribution for the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year as shown in Exhibit A – City of Central Budget 2017-18 attached hereto is hereby adopted.

Section 5. Capital Outlay & Improvement. The Dedicated Fund Budget for the Capital Outlay & Improvement for the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year as shown in Exhibit A – City of Central Budget 2017-18 attached hereto is hereby adopted.

Section 6. Amendments to the budget, including but not limited to changes within various budget classifications, require approval of the Council. Such amendments may only be made with the approval of the Council, and the power to make such amendments is reserved solely to the Council.

Section 7. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 8. Conflicts. The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against prior ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

Section 9. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.






