15 16	WHEREAS, Value Payment Systems ("VPS"), the payment processor for GovMotus charges flat fees which are less than the 4% convenience fee currently authorized;
17 18 19	WHEREAS, VPS accepts credit cards and Apple Pay not currently accepted by Central;
20 21	WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to accept additional forms of payment and to reduce the convenience fees on permits to the actual fee;

30 31 32 33 34 35 36 37 38	(b) Payment of local charges may be made via online checks, bank drafts, credit cards, MasterCard® and Discover® other electronic payment methods for the payment of any local charge exceeding \$10. Acceptance of a local charge via a payment device shall not discharge the liability therefore, until final settlement or payment of the local charge is received. The local charge will be deemed paid on the date the payment device was initially received unless the payment is returned for insufficient funds. If any payment is returned for insufficient funds, any license or permit issued shall not be valid until final payment for all local charges and costs incurred for the returned payment is received.
