ORDINANCE NO. 2019-46

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2019-2020 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO REPLACE A DAMAGED PATROL UNIT AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, a Central Police Department Patrol Unit 124, a 2018 Ford Interceptor, VIN 1FM5K8AR6JGC76019, involved in an accident was declared a total loss by the risk pool and a settlement of \$25,385.00 for the loss was received by Central in exchange for the delivery of the damaged patrol unit;

WHEREAS, the Central Police Department needs to replace Patrol Unit 124 and the estimated replacement cost is \$28,453.93;

WHEREAS, the Central Police Department requests to transfer \$3,068.93 from Repairs & Maint-Vehicles & Equip and use the settlement of \$25,385.00 to procure a new patrol unit to replace Patrol Unit 124; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2019-2020 Fiscal Year General Fund Budget as requested by the Central Police Department.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Receipt and Budget Amendment

Insurance Proceeds (General Fund Revenue Account No. 000.370.00) is hereby increased by \$25,385.00 to include proceeds for property loss for the damaged City of Central Police Department patrol unit.

Repairs & Maint-Vehicles & Equip (General Fund Revenue Account No. 000.421.70.430) is hereby decreased by \$3,068.93 to fund replacement of the damaged Central Police Department patrol unit.

Section 2. Expenditure for New Patrol Unit

Vehicles-PD (General Fund Revenue Account No. 000.421.70.742) is hereby increased by \$28,453.93 to fund replacement of the damaged Central Police Department patrol unit.

Section 3. Conflicts

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against prior ordinances of the City to the extent there is any conflict.

Section 4. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.




