ORDINANCE NO. 2019-19

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE A SPECIAL REVENUE FUND FOR THE PROCEEDS OF THE ONE-HALF CENT SALES AND USE TAX EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2019 THROUGH MARCH 31, 2049 AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, on December 8, 2018, the voters of East Baton Rouge Parish approved a one-half cent sales and use tax to be collected from April 1, 2019 through March 31, 2049 throughout East Baton Rouge Parish including within the City of Central and for for certain projects within the MovEBR Plan dated August 8, 2018 (“MovEBR Tax”);

WHEREAS, City of Central anticipates receipt of collection of the MovEBR Tax in June of 2019;

WHEREAS, the purposes of the MovEBR Tax to be received by the City of Central are restricted to:

- a. construction or improvement of roads, including drainage projects and traffic synchronization within the city of Central;
- b. constructing community enhancement projects, including drainage, lights and sidewalks, within Central; and
- c. to improve the Advanced Traffic Management Center, such improvements prioritized as determined by the Central Council.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to create a special revenue fund for the proceeds of the MovEBR Tax;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Creation. A special revenue fund designated as the MovEBR Special Revenue Fund is hereby created for all proceeds of the MovEBR Tax. Revenues in the MovEBR Speical Revenue Fund shall be subject to expenditure only in accordance with an enacted budget for the purposes approved by the voters on December 8, 2018.

Section 2. Conflicts. The specific terms of this Ordinance shall supersede prior ordinances to the extent the prior ordinance is in conflict with this Ordinance.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid.

The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.


