ORDINANCE NO. 2020-01

AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE MONTHLY COMPENSATION OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE BEGINNING FEBRUARY 1, 2020 AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the monthly compensation of Chief of Police was set by Ordinance No. 2007-11, amended and reenacted by Ordinance No. 2012-27 and amended and reenacted by Ordinance No. 2014-13;

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that due to the growth of the City of Central and the growth of the Central Police Department, the responsibilities of the Chief of Police have increased including the need for the Chief of Police to be always on duty or on call to respond to incidents;

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that the monthly compensation set for the position of Chief of Police in 2012 is inadequate for a full-time Chief of Police; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined the annual compensation of the Chief of Police should be increased from \$26,500 per year to \$53,800 beginning on February 1, 2020.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Compensation. Section 225(C) of Title 1 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

C. Chief of Police

- (1) Effective February 1, 2020 the monthly compensation of the Chief of Police for the City of Central shall be \$4,483.34.

Section 2. Conflicts. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent in conflict.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective on February 1, 2020.
