ORDINANCE NO. 2019-25

TO ADOPT AN OFFICIAL MASTER DRAINAGE PLAN, TO PROVIDE FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE OFFICIAL PLAN AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2017, the Council for the City of Central unanimously approved preparation of a Master Drainage Plan and Hazard Mitigation Assessment to guide maintenance, planning and development; and

WHEREAS, public outreach events were conducted, data was collected, draft findings were completed in March of 2019, and the proposed Drainage Master Plan and Hazard Mitigation Assessment was completed and has been available on the Central's website since March of 2019;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council for the City of Central desire to finalize the March 2019 DRAFT of the Drainage Master Plan and Hazard Mitigation Assessment as the Official Master Drainage Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council for the City of Central desire to implement the Official Master Drainage Plan as an additional tool to guide future maintenance, planning and development;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council for the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Master Drainage Plan and Hazard Mitigation Assessment. The Official Master Drainage Plan shall be the 2019 Master Drainage Plan and Hazard Mitigation Assessment prepared by CSRS, Inc.

Section 2. Implementation. The Official Master Drainage Plan shall serve as a guide for maintenance, planning and development. All city officials, employees and contractors shall be knowledgeable of the Official Master Drainage Plan and shall consult the Official Master Drainage Plan as a guide in prioritizing maintenance, when considering approval of zoning changing and in planning and development.

Section 3. Conflicts. The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against prior ordinances of the City to the extent there is any conflict.

Section 4. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid.

The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective on July 1, 2019.
