**PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 2019-\_\_\_\_**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2019-2020 FISCAL YEAR  
GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO TRANSFER \$1,000 FROM  
REPAIRS & MAINTENANCE VEHICLES & EQUIPMENT TO  
SOFTWARE FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO  
PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central included funds for various software expenditures in the 2019-2020 Fiscal Year General Fund Budget for the City of Central Police Department;

WHEREAS, the cost of the annual software renewals for the City of Central Police Department were underestimated;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to transfer funds appropriated for repairs and maintenance of police vehicles and equipment to fund software for the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2019-2020 Fiscal Year General Budget related to the above-stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

**Section 1.** Software-PD (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.421.05.000) is hereby increased by \$1,000.00 to provide for expenditures related to software renewals for the City of Central Police Department.

**Section 2.** Repairs & Maint-Vehicles & Equip (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.421.70.430) is hereby decreased by \$1,000.00 to provide funds for expenditures related to software renewals for the City of Central Police Department.

**Section 3. Conflicts**

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against prior ordinances of the City to the extent there is any conflict.

**Section 4 Severability**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the

1 validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The  
2 remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain  
3 in force and effect.
