1 BY COUNCIL MEMBER MOAK (Case No. SS-15-19) 2 3 CITY OF CENTRAL 4 PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 2019-5 AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A WAIVER TO PERMIT A PRIVATE WASTEWATER 6 7 TREATMENT PLANT 8 (Lovett Road – Tracts G-1, F-1 and F-2 of the Wylie Buhler Property) 9 10 WHEREAS, as part of an application to subdivide an approximately 2.93-acre parcel on 11 the south side of Lovett Road between Sullivan and Woods Edge Roads into three (3) residential 12 lots (with a minimum lots width and area variance having been granted by the BOA), a request 13 was made for a waiver of Sec. 7:14.3(1) of the Development Code to permit the development of 14 the property without connection to sanitary sewer; and 15 WHEREAS, though the property is within 500 feet of a public sanitary sewer, it is a 16 17 pressurized force main, making such a connection cost prohibitive to the development of only 18 three (3) lots; and 19 20 WHEREAS, the Planning Commission held a public hearing on the subject subdivision on 21 September 26, 2019 approving the subdivision and recommending approval of the sewer connection waiver; 22 23 24 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of 25 Louisiana as follows: 26 27 That the property that is the subject of this Ordinance is legally described in Section 1: 28 Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof. 29 30 Section 2: That a waiver of Sec. 7:14.3(1) of the Development Code is hereby granted 31 consistent with the "Map Showing the Subdivision of Tract F and Tract G of Wylie Buhler into 32 Tracts G-1, F-1 and F-2," Myron Lee Contractors, LLC, undated. 33 34 Section 3: The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against 35 other ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict. Except for the foregoing, 36 the development of the subject property is subject to the terms of all applicable ordinances and 37 regulations of the City of Central, including any amendment thereto. 38 39 Section 4: Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this 40 Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of 41 invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the 42 part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of

invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.
