ORDINANCE NO. 2018-50

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2018-2019 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR GENERAL LIABILITY INSURANCE PURPOSES FOR CITY HALL AND THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central did not include sufficient funds within the 2018-19 Fiscal Year General Budget for general liability insurance related to City Hall;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central appropriated more than sufficient funds within the 2018-19 Fiscal Year General Budget for general liability insurance related to the Police Department;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central wishes to correct the general liability insurance in the 2018-19 Fiscal Year General Budget to allocate funds accordingly;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year General Budget to appropriate funds necessary related to the above stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Insurance-General Liability CH (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.419.70.520) is hereby increased by \$12,363 to provide sufficient funds for general liability insurance coverage for City Hall.

Section 2. Insurance-General Liability PD (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.421.05.520) is hereby decreased by \$17,500 to reduce funds for general liability insurance coverage for the Police Department.

Section 3. Conflicts

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against prior ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

Section 4. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of

the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.






