1 **BY COUNCIL MEMBER WELLS (TA-5-19)** 2 3 **CITY OF CENTRAL** 4 PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 2019-____ 5 6 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 14 OF THE CITY OF CENTRAL 7 COMPREHENSIVE ZONING CODE ADDING A NEW SECTION 14.9 8 9 WHEREAS, In November 2013, the City of Central Comprehensive Zoning Code 10 (Appendix 1 of the City of Central Code of Ordinances) was enacted by the City Council; and 11 12 WHEREAS, from time-to-time since its enactment, various questions and issues have 13 been raised regarding the interpretation and/or application of various provisions of the Zoning 14 Code as well as the efficiencies of the zoning process; and 15 16 WHEREAS, the City Council believes that the following changes to the Zoning Code 17 will better protect the public health, safety and welfare of the City and its residents; and 18 19 WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on October 24, 2019 before the City of Central 20 Zoning Commission; and 21 22 WHEREAS, the Zoning Commission, has recommended approval the amendment set 23 forth herein. 24 25 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of 26 Louisiana as follows: 27 28 Section 1: That the City of Central Comprehensive Zoning Code (Appendix A to the 29 City of Central Code of Ordinances) be amended adding a new Section 14.9 stating: 30 "Effect of Council Denial. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary elsewhere in this 31 32 Zoning Ordinance, no application for a Planned Unit Development that also seeks a 33 zoning change will be accepted for filing and processed if a previous application for a 34 Planned Unit Development and rezoning for all or any part of the same property was 35 denied by the City Council less than one (1) year prior." 36 37 Section 2: The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against 38 other ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict. 39 40 Section 3: Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of 41 this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of 42 invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the 43 part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of 44 invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.
