ORDINANCE NO. 2020-17

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING THE GENERAL FUND BUDGET AND THE DEDICATED FUND BUDGETS FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES, DRAINAGE, AND LOCAL ROAD IMPROVEMENT & MAINTENANCE, HALF CENT SALES AND USE TAX, MOVEBR AND TRAFFIC CONTRIBUTION, CAPITAL OUTLAY & IMPROVEMENT FOR THE 2020-2021 FISCAL YEAR AND PROVIDING FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, David R. Barrow in his capacity as Mayor for the City of Central, prepared proposed budgets for the General Fund and the Dedicated Funds for Emergency Services, Drainage, and Local Road Improvement & Maintenance Fund Fee (“ESDLRIM”), Half Cent Sales and Use Tax, Traffic Contribution, Capital Outlay & Improvement, and MoveBR (collectively “Budgets”) for the fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2020 and ending on June 30, 2021 (“2020-2021 Fiscal Year”); and

WHEREAS, the proposed Budgets were submitted to the City Council for review and consideration prior to introduction; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing on the proposed Budgets was timely published in the Advocate; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the proposed Budgets was held on June 9, 2020;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana:

Section 1. General Fund. The General Fund Budget for the 2020-2021 Fiscal Year in Exhibit A, City of Central Budget 2020-21 attached hereto, is hereby adopted.

Section 2. Emergency Services, Drainage, and Local Road Improvement & Maintenance Fund Fee. The Dedicated Fund Budget for Emergency Services, Drainage, and Local Road Improvement & Maintenance Fund Fees for the 2020-21 Fiscal Year in Exhibit A, City of Central Budget 2020-21 attached hereto, is hereby adopted.

Section 3. Half-Cent Sales and Use Tax. The Dedicated Fund Budget for Half Cent Sales and Use Tax for the 2020-2021 Fiscal Year in Exhibit A, City of Central Budget 2020-21 attached hereto, is hereby adopted.

Section 4. Dedicated Fund Budget for MovEBR. The Dedicated Fund Budget for MovEBR for the 2020-2021 Fiscal Year in Exhibit A, City of Central Budget 2020-21 attached hereto, is hereby adopted.

Section 5. Traffic Contribution. The Dedicated Fund Budget for Traffic Contribution for the 2020-2021 Fiscal Year in Exhibit A, City of Central Budget 2020-21 attached hereto, is hereby adopted.

Section 6. Capital Outlay & Improvement. The Dedicated Fund Budget for Capital Outlay & Improvement for the 2020-2021 Fiscal Year in Exhibit A, City of Central Budget 2020-21 attached hereto, is hereby adopted.

Section 7. Adjustments. The Mayor is hereby authorized to adjust line items of expenditures within a program or function of a department. Such adjustments shall be reported to the City Council. To the extent actual expenditures exceed the amount appropriated by 5% or more in any fund, the Mayor shall recommend a budget amendment to the City Council for approval as required by the Louisiana Local Government Budget Act, La. R.S. 39:1201 *et seq.*

Section 8. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 9. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective on July 1, 2020.
