**ORDINANCE NO. 2017-03**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2016-2017 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE RECEIPT OF A DONATION AND EXPENDITURES FOR THE CHRISTMAS EVENT AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS**

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central did not include within the 2016-17 Fiscal Year General Budget for the City of Central, receipt of a donation from Cox of \$1,000 for the Christmas Special Event; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central did not include all expenditures related to the Christmas Special Event within the 2016-17 Fiscal Year General Budget for the City of Central; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to reduce the funds originally allocated to Publicity, Education & Conferences, and Travel and reallocate them to Special Events; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2016-2017 Fiscal Year General Budget to properly appropriate funds necessary related to the above stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

**Section 1.** Special Events (Account No. 000.464.99.001) is hereby increased by \$8,500.00 to provide for the expenditures of holding the Christmas Special Event.

**Section 3.** Publicity (Account No. 000.464.10.540) is hereby decreased by \$4,000.00 to provide adequate funds related to the expenditures of holding the Christmas Special Event.

**Section 4.** Education & Conferences (Account No. 000.464.99.270) is hereby decreased by \$3,000.00 to provide adequate funds related to the expenditures of holding the Christmas Special Event.

**Section 5.** Travel (Account No. 000.464.99.580) is hereby decreased by \$1,500.00 to provide adequate funds related to the expenditures of holding the Christmas Special Event.

**Section 6.** Donations-City (Account No. 000.364.10) is hereby increased by \$1,000.00 for the donation received in cash from Cox related to the Christmas Special Event.

**Section 7. Conflicts**

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against other ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

**Section 8. Severability**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

**Section 9. Effective Date**

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.
