ORDINANCE NO. 2018-39

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2018-2019 FISCAL YEAR GENERAL FUND BUDGET AND THE CAPITAL OUTLAY FUND BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR HOOPER ROAD DRIVEWAY CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Council desires to continue to improve drainage within the City of Central by replacing approximately 7 driveway culverts on the north side of Hooper Road east of where Beaver Bayou crosses under Hooper Road;

WHEREAS, these approximately 7 box culverts do not convey the flow required to maintain positive drainage from east to west into Beaver Bayou;

WHEREAS, the City of Central prepared and released a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for professional engineering services which includes but is not limited to design, engineering, and project management related to the Hooper Road Driveway Culvert Replacement Project;

WHEREAS, the cost of the professional engineering services for the Hooper Road Driveway Culvert Replacement Project are estimated at \$144,300;

WHEREAS, the Council did not include funding for the professional engineering services required for the Hooper Road Driveway Culvert Replacement Project in the 2018-19 Budget for the General Fund or Capital Outlay Fund;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year Budgets for the General Fund and Capital Outlay Fund to properly appropriate necessary funds related to the above stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Transfer to CO&I Fund (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.491.21.200) is hereby increased by \$144,300 to provide for the transfer of funds to the Capital Outlay Fund for expenditures related to professional engineering services for the Hooper Road Driveway Culvert Replacement Project e cleaning of off-road drainage within the City of Central.

Section 2. Transfer from General Fund (Capital Outlay Fund Revenue Account No. 210.391.00.100) is hereby increased by \$144,300 to provide for the transfer of funds from the General Fund for expenditures related to professional engineering services for the Hooper Road Driveway Culvert Replacement Project.

Section 3. Drainage (Capital Outlay Fund Expenditure Account No. 210.400.20.000) is hereby increased by \$144,300 to provide for expenditures related to professional engineering services for the Hooper Road Driveway Culvert Replacement Project.

Section 4. Conflicts

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against prior ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

Section 5. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 9. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.






