ORDINANCE NO. 2020-31

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2020-2021 FISCAL YEAR EMERGENCY SERVICES, DRAINAGE, & LOCAL ROAD IMPROVEMENTS & MAINTENANCE FUND BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE \$1,100,000 FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES AND DEBRIS REMOVAL AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the City of Central included \$30,000 for emergency services in the current year budget related to minor emergencies within the City of Central;

WHEREAS, Hurricane Delta is currently expected to threaten South Louisiana and the Governor has declared a state of emergency;

WHEREAS, the City of Central may have a need to provide timely emergency services and debris removal as a result of the storm or any future storm within this fiscal year to protect the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of the City of Central;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central did not include the costs of providing emergency services or debris removal in the wake of a major emergency;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2020-21 Fiscal Year Emergency Services, Drainage, & Local Road Improvements & Maintenance Fund Budget for anticipated costs related to providing emergency services and debris removal;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Central as follows:

Section 1. Budget Amendment

Emergency (ESDLRIM Account No. 110.431.99.000) is hereby increased by \$1,100,000 to provide for anticipated emergency services and debris removal.

Section 2. Conflicts

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against other Ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

Section 3. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of

the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.
