**ORDINANCE NO. 2018-37**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2018-2019 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR DRIVEWAY REPAIRS AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS**

WHEREAS, the City of Central has contracted with IBTS as of July 1, 2018 to repair or replace culverts within the roadway drainage system as necessary and to reimburse IBTS for concrete or asphalt materials to return private driveways to their previous conditions that were excavated during the repair or culvert replacement process; and

WHEREAS, the City of Central has repaired culverts and/or replaced culverts prior to July 1, 2018 which required existing concrete or asphalt private driveways to be excavated in order to make the necessary repairs or culvert replacements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Central desires to return these excavated concrete or asphalt private driveways repaired by IBTS since July 1, 2011 to their previous condition prior to the repairs or culvert replacements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Central did not include the costs of concrete or asphalt to return these excavated private driveways to their previous conditions prior to the repairs or culvert replacements;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year Budget to properly appropriate necessary funds related to the above-stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

**Section 1.** Storm/Street Drainage (Capital Outlay & Improvement Fund Expenditure Account No. 210.431.60.000) is hereby increased by \$110,000.00 to provide for driveway repairs related to culverts that were repaired prior to July 1, 2018.

**Section 2.** Transfer from General Fund (Capital Outlay & Improvement Fund Revenue Account No. 210.391.00.100) is hereby increased by \$110,000.00 to receive funds from the General Fund to cover expenditures related to the driveway repairs related to culverts that were repaired prior to July 1, 2018.

**Section 3.** Transfer to Capital Outlay & Improvement Fund (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.491.21.200) is hereby increased by \$110,000.00 to transfer funds to the Capital

Outlay & Improvement Fund to cover expenditures related to the driveway repairs related to culverts that were repaired prior to July 1, 2018.

**Section 4. Conflicts**

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against other Ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

**Section 5. Severability**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

**Section 6. Effective Date**

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.

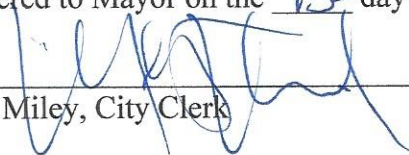

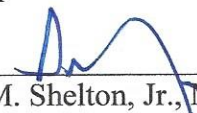

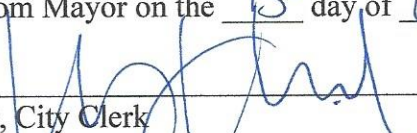
