**ORDINANCE NO. 2020-32**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2020-2021 FISCAL YEAR GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE UP TO \$20,000 FOR COMMUNITY EVENTS AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, a number of community events are scheduled to be held in the City of Central in November and December of 2020;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to fund preparations for the upcoming community events in advance of the events;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Central as follows:

**Section 1. Budget Amendment**

Community Events (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.464.40.000) is hereby increased by \$20,000 for Miscellaneous Events.

**Section 2. Conflicts**

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against other Ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

**Section 3. Severability**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

**Section 4. Effective Date**

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.


