ORDINANCE NO. 2019-34

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE FRANCHISE FEE REVENUES ALLOCATIONS WITHIN THE EMERGENCY SERVICES, DRAINAGE & LOCAL ROAD IMPROVEMENT & MAINTENANCE FUND AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to increase funding for flood control projects by reallocating the Franchise Fee Revenues within the Emergency Services, Drainage & Local Road Improvement & Maintenance Fund;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Franchise Fee Revenues

Franchise Fee Revenues within the Emergency Services, Drainage & Local Road Improvement & Maintenance Fund shall be dedicated as follows:

- A. 50% to Drainage Fund (ESDLRIM Fund Revenue Account No. 110.318.21);
- B. 25% to Emergency Fund (ESDLRIM Fund Revenue Account No. 110.318.20) until the Emergency Fund balance reaches \$15,000,000; thereafter, an additional 25% shall be dedicated to the Drainage Fund until the Emergency Fund Balance is less than \$15,000,000; and
- C. 25% to Roads Repair/Maintenance Fund (ESDLRIM Fund Revenue Account No. 110.318.22).

Section 2. Conflicts

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against prior ordinances of the City to the extent there is any conflict.

Section 3. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.




