ORDINANCE NO. 2019-21

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE GENERAL FUND BUDGET AND THE DEDICATED FUND BUDGETS FOR THE EMERGENCY SERVICES, DRAINAGE, AND LOCAL ROAD IMPROVEMENT & MAINTENANCE FUND, THE HALF CENT SALES AND USE TAX, THE TRAFFIC CONTRIBUTION, AND THE CAPITAL OUTLAY & IMPROVEMENT FUNDS FOR THE 2018-2019 FISCAL YEAR AND PROVIDING FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 2018-16 Central adopted General Fund Budget and the Dedicated Fund Budgets for the Emergency Services, Drainage, and Local Road Improvement & Maintenance Fund Fees, the Half Cent Sales and Use Tax, Traffic Contribution, and the Capital Outlay & Improvement Funds for the 2018-2019 (“the Budgets”); and

WHEREAS, the Budgets have been amended since the adoption and require additional amendment to include certain income anticipated and received and expenses anticipated and incurred since the adoption of the Budgets and subsequent amendments in order to comply with the Local Government Budget Act.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana:

Section 1. Budget Amendments. The General Fund Budget and the Dedicated Fund Budgets for the Emergency Services, Drainage, and Local Road Improvement & Maintenance Fund, the Half Cent Sales and Use Tax, Traffic Contribution, and the Capital Outlay & Improvement Funds for 2019-2020 are hereby amended as shown in Exhibit A – City of Central Budget 2018-2019 attached hereto.

Section 2. Conflicts. The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against prior ordinances of the City to the extent there is any conflict.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication in the Official Journal.


