5 PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 2019-____

7 AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE MONTHLY
8 COMPENSATION OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE BEGINNING
9 FEBRUARY 1, 2020 AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED
10 MATTERS

11
12 WHEREAS, the monthly compensation of Chief of Police was set by Ordinance No. 2007-
13 11, amended and reenacted by Ordinance No. 2012-27 and amended and reenacted by Ordinance
14 No. 2014-13;

15
16 WHEREAS, the Council has determined that due to the growth of the City of Central and
17 the growth of the Central Police Department, the responsibilities of the Chief of Police have
18 increased including the need for the Chief of Police to be always on duty or on call to respond to
19 incidents;

20
21 WHEREAS, the Council has determined that the monthly compensation set for the position
22 of Chief of Police in 2012 is inadequate for a full-time Chief of Police; and

23
24 WHEREAS, the Council has determined the annual compensation of the Chief of Police
25 should be increased from \$26,500 per year to \$53,800 beginning on February 1, 2020.

27 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of
28 Louisiana as follows:

30 **Section 1. Compensation.** Section 225(C) of Title 1 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as
31 follows:

33 C. Chief of Police

34 (1) Effective ~~July 1, 2007~~, February 1, 2020 the monthly compensation of
35 the Chief of Police for the City of Central shall be ~~\$2,208.33~~ \$4,483.34.

36 **Section 2. Conflicts.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are
37 hereby repealed to the extent in conflict.

39 **Section 3. Severability.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance
40 is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not
41 affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid.
42 The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain
43 in force and effect.

1 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall be effective on February 1, 2020.
