12	WHEREAS, the monthly compensation of Chief of Police was set by Ordinance No. 2007-
13	11, amended and reenacted by Ordinance No. 2012-27 and amended and reenacted by Ordinance
14	No. 2014-13;
15 16	WHEREAS, the Council has determined that due to the growth of the City of Central and
10 17	the growth of the Central Police Department, the responsibilities of the Chief of Police have
18	increased including the need for the Chief of Police to be always on duty or on call to respond to
19	incidents;

21	WHEREAS, the Council has determined that the monthly compensation set for the position
22	of Chief of Police in 2012 is inadequate for a full-time Chief of Police; and

24	WHEREAS, the Council has determined the annual compensation of the Chief of Police
25	should be increased from \$26,500 per year to \$53,800 beginning on February 1, 2020.
