ORDINANCE NO. 2018-46

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2018-2019 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR ARCHITECT FEES AND LEGAL NOTICE RELATED TO THE DESIGN OF A CITY HALL BUILDING AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central was awarded a grant from the State of Louisiana for the construction of a City Hall; and

WHEREAS, the City of Central expects to receive grant payments related to cost of a City Hall Building from the State of Louisiana;

WHEREAS, the City of Central 2018-19 Fiscal Year Capital Outlay & Improvement Fund Budget State Grant Revenue Account No. 210.334.30 reflects the balance available related to the awarded grant funds for the construction of a City Hall; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central wishes to allocate funds for the design costs and legal notice for a City Hall Building and that funds for these expenditures were not provided in the 2018-19 Fiscal Year General Fund or Capital Outlay & Improvement Fund Budget;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2018-19 Fiscal Year Capital Outlay & Improvement Fund and General Fund Budgets to appropriate necessary funds related to the above-stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Buildings (Capital Outlay & Improvement Fund Expenditure Account No. 210.400.10.000) is hereby increased by \$1,850.00 to provide for expenditures related to the architect fees for the design of a City Hall Building.

Section 2. Notifications (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.411.30.540) is hereby increase by \$1,270.00 to provide for expenditures related to the legal notice placed in the Advocate for a public meeting related to a City Hall Building.

Section 3. Conflicts

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against other Ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

Section 4. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.






