ORDINANCE NO. 2019-02

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2018-2019 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE \$1,545.00 FOR THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT AND HOSTING SUBSCRIPTION PROVIDE LIVE VIDEO AND AUDIO STREAMING OF PUBLIC MEETINGS ON THE CITY OF CENTRAL WEBSITE AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS.

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central, in order to increase visibility of the actions of Central's elected officials and to provide increased public involvement and awareness, desires to make a live video and audio stream of City Council and other public meetings available for live viewing on the city's website by interested citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires that these videos be archived on the city's website for on-demand viewing by interested citizens at any later date; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to allocate \$1,545.00 in order to provide for live video and audio streaming of City Council and other public meetings and that funds for these expenditures were not provided in the 2018-19 Fiscal Year General Fund Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2018-19 Fiscal Year General Fund Budget to appropriate necessary funds related to the above-stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Small Equipment (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.419.90.741) is hereby increased by \$900.00 to provide for expenditures related to providing live video and audio streaming of City Council and other public meetings.

Section 2. Dues and Subscriptions (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.419.10.000) is hereby increased by \$645.00 to provide for expenditures related to providing live video and audio streaming of City Council and other public meetings.

Section 3. Conflicts

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against other Ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

Section 4. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.




