ORDINANCE NO. 2018-02

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2017-2018 FISCAL YEAR HALF-CENT FUND BUDGET AND CAPITAL OUTLAY BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR ROAD RESURFACING PROJECTS AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Council and Mayor of the City of Central desires to resurface multiple roads within the City of Central;

WHEREAS, the City of Central estimates costs of \$650,000 related to the desired road resurfacing projects;

WHEREAS, the Council included \$500,000 for resurfacing projects within the 2017-18 Fiscal Year Half-Cent Fund and Capital Outlay Fund;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year Half-Cent Fund and Capital Outlay Fund to properly appropriate the additional \$150,000 in costs related to the above stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Transfer to CO&I Fund - Rehab (Half-Cent Fund Expenditure Account No. 120.491.21.200) is hereby increased by \$150,000 for the transfer of funds to the Capital Outlay Fund for the additional estimated costs above amounts previously budgeted for road resurfacing projects.

Section 2. Transfer from HC Fund – Rehab (Capital Outlay Fund Revenue Account No. 210.391.20.200) is hereby increased by \$150,000 to provide for transfer of funds from the Half Cent Fund to the Capital Outlay Fund for the additional estimated costs above amounts previously budgeted for road resurfacing projects.

Section 3. HC – Road Rehab (Capital Outlay Fund Expenditure Account No. 210.431.11.730) is hereby increased by \$150,000 to provide for the additional estimated costs above amounts previously budgeted for road resurfacing projects.

Section 4. Conflicts

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against other ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

Section 5. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 6. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.




