**ORDINANCE NO. 2017-06**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2016-2017 FISCAL YEAR EMERGENCY SERVICES, DRAINAGE, & LOCAL ROAD IMPROVEMENT & MAINTENANCE FUND BUDGET, GENERAL FUND BUDGET AND CAPITAL OUTLAY BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE CLEANING OF OFF-ROAD DRAINAGE WITHIN THE CITY OF CENTRAL AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS**

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes that an accumulation of flood debris from the August 12, 2016 severe rain event and river flooding has occurred in off road drainage within the City of Central;

WHEREAS, the Council desires to have the off-road drainage within the City of Central cleaned in an expedited manner;

WHEREAS, the Council did not include funding for the cleaning of off-road drainage in the 2016-17 Budget for the Emergency Services, Drainage, & Local Road Improvement & Maintenance Fund, General Fund or Capital Outlay Fund;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2016-2017 Fiscal Year Budgets for the Emergency Services, Drainage, & Local Road Improvement & Maintenance Fund, General Fund and Capital Outlay Fund to properly appropriate necessary funds related to the above stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

**Section 1.** Transfer to CO&I Fund - Drainage (ESDLRIM Account No. 110.491.21.100) is hereby increased by \$3,500,000 to provide for the transfer of funds to the Capital Outlay Fund for expenditures related to the cleaning of off-road drainage within the City of Central.

**Section 2.** Transfer to CO&I Fund (General Fund Account No. 000.491.21.200) is hereby increased by \$500,000 to provide for the transfer of funds to the Capital Outlay Fund for expenditures related to the cleaning of off-road drainage within the City of Central.

**Section 3.** Transfer from ESDLRIM Drainage (Capital Outlay Fund Account No. 210.391.10.100) is hereby increased by \$3,500,000 to provide for the transfer of funds from the ESDLRIM Fund for expenditures related to the cleaning of off-road drainage within the City of Central.

**Section 4.** Transfer from General Fund (Capital Outlay Fund Account No. 210.391.00.100) is hereby increased by \$500,000 to provide for the transfer of funds from the General Fund for expenditures related to the cleaning of off-road drainage within the City of Central.

**Section 5.** ESDLRIM – Drainage (Capital Outlay Fund Account No. 210.431.60.000) is hereby increased by \$3,500,000 to provide for expenditures related to the cleaning of off-road drainage within the City of Central.

**Section 6.** Drainage (Capital Outlay Fund Account No. 210.400.20.000) is hereby increased by \$500,000 to provide for the expenditures related to the cleaning of off-road drainage within the City of Central.

**Section 7. Conflicts**

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against prior ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

**Section 8. Severability**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

**Section 9. Effective Date**

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.




