ORDINANCE NO. 2018-30

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2018-2019 FISCAL YEAR GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE INCREASE OF INTERNET & TELEPHONE SERVICES FROM COX AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the City of Central desires to establish an Emergency Operations Center at City Hall;

WHEREAS, the establishment of the Emergency Operations Center at City Hall will require enhanced internet and telephone services from Cox;

WHEREAS, the Council did not provide for the cost of the enhanced internet and telephone services for the Emergency Operations Center in the 2018-19 General Fund Budget;

WHEREAS, The Council and Mayor desires to amend the 2018-2019 Fiscal Year General Budget to appropriate funds for enhanced internet and telephone services related to the above stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Telephone (Expenditure Account No. 000.419.90.530) is hereby increased by \$350.00 to provide the enhanced telephone services required to establish the Emergency Operations Center at City Hall.

Section 2. Internet (Expenditure Account No. 000.419.90.531) is hereby increased by \$3,500.00 to provide funds for the enhanced internet services required to establish the Emergency Operations Center at City Hall

Section 3. Conflicts

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against other ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

Section 4. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of

the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 5. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.




