ORDINANCE NO. 2020-02

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2019-2020 FISCAL YEAR GENERAL FUND BUDGET TO TRANSFER \$11,375.00 FROM SALARY FOR POLICE DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES TO SALARY FOR CHIEF OF POLICE AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Council approved an ordinance amending the salary of the Chief of Police effective on February 1, 2020;

WHEREAS, since the adoption of the 2019-2020 Fiscal Year General Fund Budget the number of paid officers has been reduced:

WHEREAS, the reduction in the number of paid officers will reduce expenditures for salaries of Central Police Department employees;

WHEREAS, the reduction in expenditures for paid officers is sufficient to fund the salary increase for the Chief of Police for the 2019-2020 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2019-2020 Fiscal Year General Fund Budget to transfer \$11,375.00 from the line item for salaries of Central Police Department employees to the line item for the salary of the Chief of Police.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Salary/Wages-Chief (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000-421.05.110) is hereby increased by \$11,375.00 to fund the compensation increase for the Chief of Police.

Section 2. Salary/Wages-Employees, (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000-421.20.110) is hereby decreased by \$11,375.00 to fund the compensation increase for the Chief of Police.

Section 3. Conflicts

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against prior ordinances of the City to the extent there is any conflict.

Section 4 Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective on February 1, 2020 only if the salary of the Chief of Police is increased.




