CITY OF CENTRAL
ORDINANCE NO. 2019-43

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12.2 OF THE CITY OF CENTRAL
COMPREHENSIVE ZONING CODE

WHEREAS, In November 2013, the City of Central Comprehensive Zoning Code (Appendix 1 of the City of Central Code of Ordinances) was enacted by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, from time-to-time since its enactment, various questions and issues have been raised regarding the interpretation and/or application of various provisions of the Zoning Code as well as the efficiencies of the zoning process; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes that the following changes to the Zoning Code will better protect the public health, safety and welfare of the City and its residents; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on October 24, 2019 before the City of Central Zoning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Commission, has recommended approval the amendments set forth herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1: That Section 12.2 of the City of Central Comprehensive Zoning Code (Appendix A to the City of Central Code of Ordinances) is amended removing the “.” At the end of paragraph “K” and adding a new paragraph “L”:

“L. Utility uses, including water filtration plants, pumping stations, and reservoirs.”

Section 2: The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against other ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

Section 3: Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.


