ORDINANCE NO. 2019-51

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2019-2020 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE \$115,000 TO REPLACE DRIVEWAYS REMOVED TO REPAIR CULVERTS WITHIN THE ROADWAY DRAINAGE SYSTEM AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the City of Central has contracted with IBTS beginning July 1, 2018 to repair or replace culverts within the roadway drainage system as necessary and to reimburse IBTS for concrete or asphalt materials to replace driveways excavated during the repair or replacements of culverts;

WHEREAS, the City of Central has excavated driveways to repair or replace culverts and desires to replace driveways and to reimburse IBTS for concrete or asphalt materials;

WHEREAS, the City of Central will also repair or replace additional culverts identified during the current fiscal year which will require concrete or asphalt driveways to be excavated in order to repair or replace culverts;

WHEREAS, the current budget does not include sufficient funds to cover the costs of concrete or asphalt to repair or replace excavated private driveways;

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of to replace driveways removed to repair culverts within the roadway drainage system during the 2019-2020 fiscal year is \$113,809.12; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2019-2020 Fiscal Year Budget to appropriate funds to replace driveways excavated to repair or replace culverts.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Storm/Street Drainage (Capital Outlay & Improvement Fund Expenditure Account No. 210.431.60.700) is hereby increased by \$115,000.00 to provide for expenditures related to the driveway repairs associated with culvert repairs and/or replacements.

Section 2. Transfer from General Fund (Capital Outlay & Improvement Fund Revenue Account No. 210.391.00.100) is hereby increased by \$115,000.00 to receive funds from the General Fund to cover expenditures related to the driveway repairs associated with culverts repairs and/or replacements.

Section 3. Transfer to Capital Outlay & Improvement Fund (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.491.21.200) is hereby increased by \$115,000.00 to transfer funds to the Capital Outlay & Improvement Fund to cover expenditures related to the driveway repairs associated with culverts repairs and/or replacements.

Section 4. Conflicts

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against prior ordinances of the City to the extent there is any conflict.

Section 5. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 6. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.


