ORDINANCE NO. 2019-40

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2019-2020 FISCAL YEAR GENERAL BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDS FOR GENERAL LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT BY \$4,100 AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, there are insufficient funds within the 2019-2020 Fiscal Year General Budget for General Liability Insurance for the City of Central Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2019-2020 Fiscal Year General Budget to appropriate funds necessary related to the above stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

Section 1. Budget Amendment

Insurance-Liability (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.421.05.520) is hereby increased by \$4,100.00 to provide sufficient funds for liability insurance coverage for the City of Central Police Department.

Section 2. Conflicts

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against prior ordinances of the City to the extent there is any conflict.

Section 3. Severability

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

Section 4. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.
