7 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2019-2020 FISCAL  
8 YEAR GENERAL BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF CENTRAL  
9 POLICE DEPARTMENT OFFICE AND TO PROVIDE FOR  
10 RELATED MATTERS

11  
12 WHEREAS, Chief of Police Roger Corcoran, has evaluated the funds remaining in the  
13 2019-2020 Fiscal Year General Budget for the City of Central Police Department Office;

14  
15 WHEREAS, Chief Corcoran has determined that the 2019-2020 Fiscal Year General  
16 Budget for the City of Central Police Department Office adopted did not include funding for  
17 replacement of obsolete radios for the Police Department;

18  
19 WHEREAS, Chief Corcoran requests amendment to the 2019-2020 Fiscal Year General  
20 Budget to move funding from one category to another category to cover the costs to replace the  
21 obsolete radios; and

22  
23 WHEREAS, the amendment does not increase the total funding allocated in the 2019-2020  
24 Fiscal Year General Budget for the City of Central Police Department Office.

26 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of  
27 Louisiana as follows:

29 **Section 1. Decrease in Budgeted Funds.**

30  
31 A. Salary/Wages-Employees (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.421.20.110) is  
32 hereby reduced by \$51,000.

33  
34 **Section 2. Increase in Budgeted Funds**

35  
36 A. Equipment-PD (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.421.05.741) is hereby  
37 increased by \$51,000.

39 **Section 3. Conflicts**

40  
41 The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against prior ordinances of the  
42 City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

43  
44 **Section 4. Severability**

1 If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of  
2 competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of  
3 the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of  
4 the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and  
5 effect.

7 **Section 5. Effective Date**

9 This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.
