- 1) Call to Order Mayor Shelton called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.
- 2) Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance *Ron Erickson*
- 3) Roll Call Present: Council Members Ellis, Evans, Fralick, Messina, and Vance Absent: None
- 4) Approval of the minutes from the August 9, 2016, council meeting

b) PUD-1-16 The Lakes at Woodland Grove: PUD Preliminary Development Plan (sent back to Zoning Commission by Council). An ordinance to rezone and grant a Conditional Use Permit and Preliminary Plan approval for a Planned Unit Development consisting of 175 single family residential lots and an office park located on approximately 172.2 acres on the north side of Wax Road between the Sullivan Road and Old Wax Road intersections (The Lakes at Woodland Grove). Applicant: Blake Seguin (By Council Member Ellis)
