**ORDINANCE NO. 2018-15**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2017-2018 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR UNIFORMS AND EDUCATION & CONFERENCES AND TO ACCOUNT FOR A REDUCTION IN WEAPONS FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TO PROVIDE FOR RELATED MATTERS**

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central included funds in weapons for purchase of weapons in the 2017-18 Fiscal Year General Fund Budget for the City of Central Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central recognizes that adequate funds for Uniforms and Education & Conferences were not provided in the 2017-18 Fiscal Year General Fund Budget for the City of Central Police Department;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central wishes to reduce the funds allocated to Weapons and reallocate those funds to Uniforms and Education & Conferences within the Central Police Department;

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Central desires to amend the 2017-2018 Fiscal Year General Budget to properly appropriate necessary funds related to the above-stated matters.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Central, State of Louisiana as follows:

**Section 1.** Uniforms (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.421.20.800) is hereby increased by \$1,000.00 to provide for expenditures related to uniform expenditures for the City of Central Police Department.

**Section 2.** Education & Conferences (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.421.55.270) is hereby increased by \$1,000.00 to provide for expenditures related to education and conferences for the City of Central Police Department.

**Section 3.** Weapons (General Fund Expenditure Account No. 000.421.05.748) is hereby decreased by \$2,000.00 so that additional funds related to uniforms and education and conferences can be provided for the City of Central Police Department.

**Section 4. Conflicts**

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against prior Ordinances of the City to the extent that there may be any conflict.

**Section 5. Severability**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or provision of this Ordinance is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such declaration of invalidity shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole, or parts thereof, other than the part declared invalid. The remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by the declaration of invalidity and shall remain in force and effect.

**Section 6. Effective Date**

This Ordinance shall be effective upon publication.




